	<p>business-to-business contracts and international litigation, through the creation of a worldwide framework of rules relating to jurisdiction agreements (also known as forum selection clauses) in civil and commercial matters, and the subsequent recognition and enforcement of a judgment given by a court of a contracting state designated in a choice of court agreement.</p> <p>For Georgia the Convention is significant as after the ratification, the Georgian court judgements will be enforceable throughout the EU and some non-EU states (which are the parties to the Convention), where the Georgian court had jurisdiction under an exclusive jurisdiction clause – even if no other arrangements on jurisdiction and enforcement are agreed between Georgia and the parties of the Convention. To proceed with the ratification process, it is necessary to analyze compliance of the legislation of Georgia with the 2005 Choice of Court Agreements Convention and to identify areas, where legal provisions need amendments.
